Robert M. Peskin, DDS



Dr. Robert M. Peskin graduated from Stony Brook University School of Dental Medicine in 1977. He subsequently completed General Practice and Dental Anesthesiology Residencies at Long Island Jewish Medical Center. Since 1983, he has maintained a private dental anesthesiology practice devoted primarily to the management of the anxious, apprehensive and special needs patients in

Garden City, New York. In addition, he provides in-office anesthesia for other dentists throughout the Greater New York metropolitan area.

Dr. Peskin is a nationally-recognized leader in dental anesthesiology, having served on the Board of Directors of the American Dental Society of Anesthesiology and as Speaker of its House of Delegates. He is also a Diplomat of the National Dental Board of Anesthesiology and a Fellow of the American and International Colleges of Dentists, the American Dental Society of Anesthesiology, and the Academy of General Dentistry.

In July, 2011, Dr. Peskin was named Director of the Dental Anesthesiology Residency Program at Wyckoff Heights Medical Center located in Brooklyn, NY. He is also a Clinical Associate Professor in the Department of Hospital Dentistry at Stony Brook University School of Dental Medicine, and an Assistant Attending in the Department of Dental Medicine at Long Island Jewish Medical Center.

Staying On Top of Your Game:

Challenges Facing the Anesthesia Provider in Dental Practice

This course will begin with a discussion about the current ADA Guidelines (both Use and Teaching) and Policy Statement, and explore the controversies surrounding the requirement of capnography for moderate sedation which was so hotly debated at last November's ADA Annual Session. This will lead to an in-depth review of monitoring currently being used in the delivery of office-based anesthesia. There will also be a pharmacological review of the agents currently being employed for intravenous and enteral sedation, as well as a discussion of some of the recent additions to the local anesthetic armamentarium. Dr. Peskin will also review the techniques he and his dental anesthesiology residents are utilizing in the outpatient setting. The presentation will conclude with a review of the management of the emergencies that can arise from the delivery of office-based anesthesia.

AED Rebate Program

- The AED rebate program is available only to regular NJDSA members who have paid full membership dues for the year prior to their request.
- Documentation will need to be provided from the ADSA's web site to show the active member status of the rebate applicant.
- A copy of a paid receipt for a new AED will need to be provided, not for reprogramming of an older model or supplies purchased.
- A photograph or photocopy of the back of the new AED needs to be provided showing the unit's serial number to be verified on the purchase receipt.
- One AED rebate per member per year.

Sim Man & Anesthesia Assistant Incentives

- The tuition stipend program is available only to regular NJDSA members (or their assistant employees) who have paid full membership dues for at least one the year prior to their request for this member benefit.
- A tuition stipend of:
 - \$100 is contingent upon the doctors successful completion of a "Sim Man" course provided through the ADSA
 - \$75 is contingent upon the successful completion of the 2 day anesthesia assistant course provided through the ADSA
- Documentation will need to show that full course tuition was paid to the ADSA for the course.
- The applicant needs to provide a copy of the certificate showing successful course completion with the awarding of 4-4.5 hours of CE credits for the "Sim Man" course or the CE certificate of completion in the case of the anesthesia assistant program.
- One each tuition stipend per member.
